Qingdao (German: Tsingtau), also known in the West by its postal map spelling Tsingtao, is a major city with a population of over 8.715 million (2010 census) in eastern Shandong province, Eastern China. Its built up area, made of 7 urban districts and 5 county-level cities, is home to about 4,896,000 inhabitants in 2010.



Qingdao is administered at the sub-provincial level. Lying across the Shandong Peninsula while looking out to the Yellow Sea, Qingdao is a major seaport, naval base, and industrial centre. It is also the site of the Tsingtao Brewery. The world's longest sea bridge, the Qingdao Haiwan Bridge, links the main urban area of Qingdao with Huangdao district, straddling the Jiaozhou Bay sea areas. In 2009 and 2011, Qingdao was named China's most livable city.



It also serves as a flagship city for China's marine-related research due to the fact that Ocean University of China (OUC), China's most renowned and dynamic university in the field of Marine Sciences and education, locates here.
